**Lee Tung Avenue Presents: LTA CHRISTMAS DISCO: Glitz n' Glam Party
Asia's Biggest Mirror Ball Brings Back Golden Disco Era
Christmas Party, Student Dance Contest and Charity Sale
Connect Community with Festive Grooves this Holiday Season**



(Hong Kong, 19 December 2022) A retro disco party has just kicked off in the heart of Wan Chai! From today to 2 January 2023, Lee Tung Avenue is turning into a nostalgic disco dancehall, with Asia's biggest mirror ball measuring 7 metres in diameter shining above the Central Piazza. Professional stage lighting will radiate off the mirror ball to send a confetti of light over the shopping street, which also dons glittering decorations. Golden hits from the 1970s and 80s will get everyone unleashing their inner dancing king and queen and celebrating the halcyon days of disco.

As part of its continued effort to promote creativity and arts development among young people, Lee Tung Avenue is organising the first-ever LTA DISCO Dance Contest for tertiary students under the disco theme, with young dancers reinterpreting disco dance moves and music as a tribute to the 70s culture.

Asia's biggest mirror ball 7 metres in diameter



Retro never goes out of vogue. In recent years, youngsters have been embracing cultural products from half a century ago, be they vintage fashion, oldies, roller skates, or even cassette tapes, and the disco culture is among the things whose popularity has been revived. Riding on the trend, Lee Tung Avenue has decided to recreate a disco from the 70s with the biggest disco ball Asia has ever seen – 7 metres in diameter, the ball is covered by over 2,000 mirrors and topped with mistletoe for the festive occasion. Professional stage lighting will be projected onto the disco ball dangling above the Central Piazza to throw a confetti of light on the shopping avenue, which is at the same time decorated with sequins reminiscent of 70s fashion. Shoppers will find themselves travelling back in time as soon as they step into Lee Tung Avenue, the hottest party venue and photo spot in town this Christmas.



Topping off the disco setting is a playlist of classic tunes from the 70s and 80s, compiled by Ms Josie Ho, a versatile Hong Kong Artist, music director and charity ambassador of the LTA CHRISTMAS DISCO. In the coming month or so, “Disco Fever” sessions will be held every half hour between 6pm and 9:30pm, during which disco hits and Christmas pop songs will be played and stage lighting will be shining, coaxing everyone into dancing, jiving and having the time of their life.

LTA DISCO Dance Contest for Tertiary Students

Judges praise contest which offers student dancers learning experience and cash prizes for promoting dancing culture



Lee Tung Avenue has long been supporting young people to develop their potential in arts and unleash their creativity. Riding on the theme of the winter campaign, Lee Tung Avenue organised the first-ever LTA DISCO Dance Contest for Tertiary Students to provide a platform for young dancers to perform and learn from one another. As a tribute to the time-honoured disco culture, the finalists were asked to incorporate elements of retro disco music or dance into their contemporary dance genres.

During the final which was successfully held on 10 December 2022, eight teams of dancers from various tertiary institutions who were specially dressed for the occasion performed different dances in tandem with upbeat disco music and interpreted the 70s culture in eye-opening ways. Their exuberant performances drew a crowd to the shopping street. Time and again, the spectators cheered on and applauded the dancers, drumming up the exciting atmosphere.

Three professional, veteran dancers were invited to be the judges of the dance contest: Doug.LeeFunk, one of the pioneering street dancers in Hong Kong; Oceann Wong, a freelance dancer and choreographer with 15 years of experience under his belt; and Frankie Chan, who specialises in freestyle, waacking and hip hop.

After careful deliberation by the judges, 5GUYS from Hong Kong Baptist University (HKBU) was crowned champion, taking home a cash prize of HK\$10,000. Waack.Soul.Punk, formed by students from the Chinese University of Hong Kong (CU), the University of Hong Kong (HKU), the Hong Kong Institute of Vocational Education (IVE) (Kwun Tong) and Lingnan University (LU), was selected as the first runner-up and awarded HK\$5,000, while CU's Happs came third and received HK\$2,000.

A representative of 5GUYS said: “We are extremely happy to win the first prize in the dance contest, and it was also an exciting experience to see the other teams performing dance genres other than our own in different styles. Our specialty is funk. For the contest, we performed locking along 70s disco music to demonstrate the chemistry between disco and funk. We chose The Jacksons’ “Blame it on the Boogie” as our opening song precisely to conjure up the disco. The 1970s may seem far remote from university students like us, but we still hope our performance has introduced more people to disco funk music, parties and dances from different eras.”

Another contestant said: “The epidemic has deprived us of performing opportunities. Thanks to Lee Tung Avenue, we are able to get on stage and perform again. The contest also gave us an opportunity to learn from other dancers and motivated us to work hard for our passion and dreams.”

The judges said: “We are impressed by the creativity and performances of the student dancers. They are full of potential and it is encouraging to see the next generation of dancers working hard for what they love. The dance contest, staged on this pleasant pedestrian street under a massive, eye-catching mirror ball, has no doubt drawn public attention and helped promote the development of dance in Hong Kong. We also enjoyed the combination of disco and funk. But the most important of all is that the dancers were able to enjoy themselves and unleash their potential in music.”


