**Lee Tung Avenue Presents “Lanterns-Lit Year of the Rabbit”  
Colourful Lanterns & Rabbit Ornaments Beckon Good Fortune  
Master-Led Traditional Chinese Art Workshops & Spending Rewards**

(Hong Kong, 4 January 2023) Soon it will be Lunar New Year, one of the most important festivals in Hong Kong. As a popular place for festive celebrations, Lee Tung Avenue will be greeting the public with “Lanterns-lit Year of the Rabbit” from 13 January to 10 April 2023, which will turn the 200-metre walking street into an atmospheric outdoor destination.

In addition to 688 eye-catching traditional Chinese red lanterns, the street will be adorned with glittering sequins in gold and red, colours associated with prosperity and happiness. Every day at 5pm, the lanterns will be switched on to create a truly festive scene, best for photo-taking and gatherings with family and friends.

With the Year of the Rabbit coming up, the gentle, adorable animal will be a common sight at Lee Tung Avenue: sculptures of rabbits holding small lanterns on the nostalgic lampposts across the shopping street, and a light installation of a family of five rabbits at the Central Piazza symbolising *ng fook lam moon* (five blessings entering one’s home).

### **Red Envelopes Inspired by Iconic Lee Tung Avenue Elements**



Inspired by its unique architectural characteristics, Lee Tung Avenue has designed an exquisite set of red envelopes this year. Iconic European-style terraces and vintage-style lampposts are juxtaposed with the shopping street's signature festive elements like begonia and traditional red lanterns. Incorporating the concept of Chinese paper cutting, the set of red envelopes is a tribute to traditional Chinese art and craftsmanship.

Between 8 and 21 January 2023, shoppers can redeem one set (eight envelopes per set) of the limited-edition red envelopes by spending HK\$500 or more at Lee Tung Avenue with an electronic payment method.

### **CNY Spending Rewards**

To drum up the festivities, between 8 January and 28 February 2023, shoppers can redeem one HK\$50 dining discount coupon and one HK\$50 shopping discount coupon upon spending HK\$1,000 at Lee Tung Avenue with an electronic payment method.



On 14 and 15 January 2023, Lee Tung Avenue will be organising various cultural activities for the public to celebrate the festive season and immerse in traditional Chinese culture.

### **Sugar Blowing Workshop**

The art of sugar blowing dates back to over 600 years ago. In 2014, the blown sugar technique was included in the first Intangible Cultural Heritage Inventory of Hong Kong. Due to dwindling interest among the younger generation to succeed the trade, the art form is in danger of disappearing.



To introduce this invaluable cultural heritage to the public, Lee Tung Avenue has invited sugar blowing artist Clemen Lo to host a workshop, where she will demonstrate different sugar blowing techniques like kneading and pulling and guide the participants to make a tangerine sculpture with maltose. Shoppers can redeem one spot in the workshop by presenting an electronic payment receipt(s) from the same day issued by a Lee Tung Avenue shop(s).

In 2019, Clemen Lo participated in the Jockey Club ICH+ Innovative Heritage Education Programme initiated by Lingnan University and Hong Kong Art School, during which she trained under a sugar blowing artist for a year and helped promote the art at secondary schools. In 2020, Lo set up the.sugar.art to raise awareness of and pass on the art through taking part in exhibitions and organising workshops, and incorporating modern, creative elements into the traditional art form.

### **Chinese Paper-Cutting Workshop**

Chinese paper cutting is a well-kept traditional folk art. During important festivals and celebrations like weddings, Chinese people like to use auspicious patterns cut out from bright red paper to decorate their homes. To celebrate the arrival of spring, Lee Tung Avenue has invited renowned Chinese paper-cutting artist Li Yun Xia to host a workshop, where she will explain and demonstrate paper-cutting techniques and guide the participants to cut a few Lunar New Year patterns including lantern and rabbit. Shoppers can redeem one spot in the workshop by presenting an electronic payment receipt(s) from the same day issued by a Lee Tung Avenue shop(s).



At the age of six, Li Yun Xia began learning paper cutting with her grandmother and mother, both paper-cutting artists themselves. Li has won awards in a great number of international and national competitions and is listed in *Who's Who in the World (Chinese Volume)* and many other national and international biographical dictionaries.

### **Free Fai Chun Written by Calligrapher on Site**

Lee Tung Avenue has invited calligrapher Adrian Lau to write *fai chun* for those visiting the shopping street on 14 & 15 January 2023. Members of the public can get one *fai chun* for free simply by following Lee Tung Avenue on social media.
